- 3. The essay should be a minimum of 3 full pages and maximum of 5 full pages (excluding works cited) should be double-spaced with 12-point Arial font, and have 1-inch margins.
- 4. A blinded committee will review eligible essays to select three finalists based on organization of information, spelling and punctuation. The finalists will be keynote speakers and honored at the IAC Annual Meeting in Las Vegas and awarded travel scholarships to attend the 2019 IAC Youth Conference in Las Vegas.
- In addition, 95 essay contestants will be awarded a full travel scholarship to attend the 2019 IAC Youth Conference in Las Vegas, December 9-12, 2019.
